This event is part of the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Garbage Can Decorating Competition which will be held at the Festival Marketplace Shopping Centre, 1067 Ontario Street, in Stratford from April 20<sup>th</sup> to April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018, inspired by our local Agriculture, the theme is **“Celebrating Agriculture”** with a focus on pollinators.
2. The City of Stratford has made available 20 drums that are used as litter containers in the park system and our goal is to have the schools decorate and beautify these containers and feature the City of Stratford slogan and theme of **“Celebrating Agriculture”** on each of the completed barrels.
3. The entry form and request for Park Garbage Drum must be received by Friday March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 in order to complete the process for delivering the drums to the schools between March 19<sup>th</sup> and Friday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>. Drums now available as Registration Forms received.
4. The deadline for completed competition entries is 9:00 pm, Tuesday, April 16<sup>th</sup> 2018.

6. All drums must include the phrase **“Celebrating Agriculture”** in the artwork and the school name must be located around the base in 2” or less sized lettering.
7. Any drum decorated for this competition must be clean and free of garbage when submitted.
8. The judging for the competition will begin at 11:00 am Wednesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018, with results announced at Festival Marketplace/Winners Court or [www.stratfordshopping.ca](http://www.stratfordshopping.ca) on April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2018.
9. All completed cans will be displayed in Queen’s Park in Stratford for the spring, summer and fall seasons.
10. All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation for taking part in this 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Garbage Can Decorating Competition and there will be a trophy for the most creative school entry in both high school and elementary school categories.
